#### Make it Memorable

Your celebrant should be a helpful resource as you plan for your wedding. Couples typically choose scriptural readings, write petitions, and invite the participation of family and friends as readers, gift bearers, and, if qualified, as extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion.

Music is provided for an additional charge.

A Jesuit staff member in charge of music for the Chapel of the North American Martyrs will contact the couple once a date is confirmed.

Music choices for your wedding liturgy must be clearly identifiable as prayers by all gathered.

Secular music may not be used.



6:00pm - 10:00pm	Wedding at 7:00pm


# Facility Use Fees

This contribution will assure that the Phelan Chapel is staffed and available to you for your wedding rehearsal and properly readied on the day and time of your wedding. Rehearsals are included in the cost of renting the chapel, whether or not you choose to have a rehearsal.

# Next Steps

- Select and confirm a Roman Catholic priest or deacon to witness your marriage. A visiting priest or deacon must be a cleric in good standing in his diocese and show that he is in compliance with the charter requirements of the Diocese of Sacramento.
- The Roman Catholic priest or deacon must complete and sign the Celebrant's Agreement to Prepare and Officiate the Sacrament at a Wedding at the Phelan Chapel of the North American Martyrs found on the Jesuit website.
- Your Roman Catholic priest or deacon will verify that you are prepared for marriage, according to the guidelines of the Diocese of Sacramento. Jesuit High School does not have a marriage preparation program.
- Coordinate with Paul LeBoeuf and discuss specific arrangements regarding music, florists, photographers.
- You must obtain a wedding license from Sacramento County, California and bring it to the rehearsal.

It is the responsibility of the engaged couple to take seriously the planning of the wedding liturgy. To assist the couple, suggested readings, music guidelines and a wedding planning sheet are available from the Jesuit High School Campus Ministry Office.
