

Meet: Jesuit Invitational Track Meet

Where: Walt Lange Track, Hanson McClain Advisors Stadium
Jesuit High School

Facilities: Walt Lange Track is a 400 meter Beynon surface. The horizontal jump runways and vertical jump areas possess the same surface. The throwing circles are brushed concrete. A grass warm up area is located adjacent to the stadium.

Parking: Jesuit High School will be in session this day. Team buses are asked to drop athletes at the stadium gate at the intersection of Tennyson and American River Drive (4741 American River Dr. Carmichael CA on Google maps) . Rio Americano HS will not be in session for remote team bus parking. Personal vehicles should plan to park along American River Drive and enter by the same gate. Entrance will only be available on American River Drive.

Admission: Adults-\$5.00;
Students (w/SB card) & Seniors- \$3.00;
Children under 12 free.

Team Packets: Team Packets should be picked up starting at 8:00 am at the entrance gate. Entry fees must be paid to receive your team packets. **Athlete and Coach wristbands will be included in the meet packet.**

Athlete entry: Athletes will enter through the designated team entry gate.

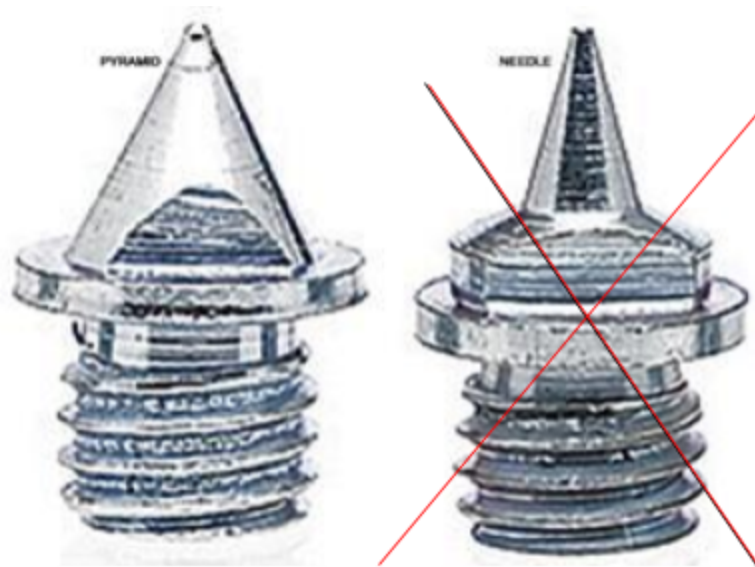
Entries: Entries will be processed through Athletic.net

Entry Fees: 4 divisions (FSB, FSG, VB & VG). \$75 per division, with a \$250 cap per team. Teams with less than 12 competing athletes will have an entry fee of **\$10 per athlete**
Make Checks payable to: **Jesuit High School Track and Field** or pay with cash.

Entry Deadline: Meet entries must be finalized on Athletic.net by Sunday, April 9th, at 11:59 PM. No additional entries will be accepted after this date.

Event Check-in: All running event/relay teams must check in with the clerk of the course 30 minutes prior to their event. Field event competitors will check in at the respective event site at least 30 minutes prior to the event.

Spikes: 3/16 inch pyramid spike only. No needle or pin spikes allowed. Pyramid spikes will be on sale (\$5.00 for a bag of 16)



Field Events: The horizontal jumps and throws will be conducted in seeded flights. Athletes will receive 3 preliminary attempts. The top 8 will have a final flight with 3 additional attempts.

Minimum Marks: Field Event athletes will have their first legal mark measured. Any mark thereafter must meet the minimum distance to be measured.

Awards: Top 3 individuals in open races and field events will receive medals. The top 3/winning relay team will medal. Awards will be presented after the conclusion of the event. **Awards not received at the respective award ceremony may be picked up by the coach only from the awards area at any time. Awards will not be mailed.**

Scoring: The top 8 places will score points in each event. (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1)

Team Tents: Team Tents will be allowed at the very top of the home bleachers. A designated “Olympic Village” will be chalked out on the warmup area for placing team tents as well. **Please note:** the visitor bleachers are closed to spectators and team tents.

Restrooms: Restrooms will be available in the pool building behind the home bleachers. **A limited number of porta potties will also be available in the warmup area.**

First Aid: Limited athletic training services (first aid) will be provided and located at the finish line.

Concessions: Food and drinks will be available at the stadium snack bar adjacent to the home bleachers. A commemorative T-Shirt (\$15) will be available in a limited supply.

Time Schedule: Heats, Flights and a final time schedule will be **April 10** at Athletic.net.
