

Scope and Sequence

There are various courses that an incoming Freshman would take, depending on his ability level. These are shown below.

The B track courses help those students who benefit from courses that go at a slower pace. There is a fuller description of B courses in the section on **Selection Process for Remedial Placement** in section 3.

The XL and Honors courses are aimed at students who benefit from courses that go at a faster pace and cover more material than the regular courses. There is a fuller description of XL and Honors courses in the section on **Selection Process for Honors/AP Math Courses** in Section 3.

There is flexibility for movement in the tracking of a student. If a student achieves A+ in the B track, he can move to regular. Similarly, if a student achieves A+ in the regular track, he can move to Honors. If a student is struggling in the level he is in, he can move down to the appropriate course.
