

Parents: Please review the procedures listed below with your son and help him to prepare the proper forms for submission to his school. Because of the volume of applicants, please *do not* contact the Admissions Office to verify receipt of forms; we will contact you if your son's application is incomplete.

1. Application for Admission (Page 1, 2 & 3)

Complete the "Application for Admission" form and the "Applicant Interest" form.

Freshman submit by February 3, 2012. Transfers submit by April 27, 2012.

2. Pastor/Minister Recommendation Form

Each applicant must present the enclosed recommendation form to his religious leader for verification of involvement. Applicants who are not currently active in their faith are required to provide an explanation letter in lieu of the Pastor/Minister Recommendation Form, as to why they would chose to apply to a faith based program, specifically Jesuit High School.

3. Academic Record Report

Print your information at the top of the form and sign for the release of transcripts. Give this form to the appropriate school official to complete and mail to Jesuit High School by due date listed on form.

4. Recommendation Forms:

- Principal Recommendation**
- Math Recommendation**
- English Recommendation**

Print your information at the top of each form and sign for the release of the requested information. Give each form to the appropriate person to complete and mail to Jesuit High School by due date listed on form.

5. 9th Grade Applicant Student-Parent Interview Schedule (Transfers see Calendar below)

Each applicant and at least one parent are required to attend an interview. Please refer to the enclosed schedule for your interview time. Waiting time will vary according to alpha groupings. The actual length of the interview will be approximately 15—30 minutes.

6. Financial Aid Forms

Financial Aid Forms will be available online at www.jesuithighschool.org. Financial need is assessed independently of admission qualifications. Please review and submit the financial aid application directly to the Private School Aid Service (PSAS) by February 24, 2012. 7. Additional Recommendations

Each applicant has the right to submit additional letters of recommendation for the Admissions Committee to consider. Please understand that there is a wealth of information already provided on your son's behalf; therefore, we ask that you be judicious in submitting additional letters.
