Dress Code Guidelines for Homecoming

Girls may wear halter, strapless and spaghetti strap dresses as long as the dress is modest, in good taste and appropriate for the girl's body type. **Skirt or dresses shorter than three inches above the knee (center of the knee) are not permitted & couples will not be allowed to enter the dance**

Boys are to wear a dress shirt, tie, dress slacks or docker style pants.

Everyone is to wear dress shoes (absolutely no tennis shoes).

The following items are NOT allowed:

- **Skirt or dresses shorter than three inches above the knee**
 - * Midriff bearing clothing or sheer/see-through fabric
 - * Denim
 - * Plunging neckline—front or back (may not go below the shoulder blades in back)
 - * Flip-flops
 - * Cargo pants
 - * Most items listed as not acceptable for open dances are not allowed for date dances

BEHAVIOR CODE – Students exhibiting the following may be asked to leave:

- Straddling or wrapping legs around another person
- Fondling, groping or inappropriate physical contact
- Lying or sitting on tables or floor
- Moshing, freaking or other types of dancing that are lewd or potentially dangerous
- Possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or other contraband

Jesuit reserves the right to randomly breathalyze any student. We also use the services of Interquest Detection Canines to survey cars and bags for contraband.
