Zac Koerner Named Jesuit High School Head Water Polo Coach

SACRAMENTO, CA (January 7, 2015) – Jesuit High School has named Zac Koerner as the head water polo coach starting February 1, 2015.

Koerner joins the Marauders after spending the past four years on the coaching staff of the University of Pacific as an assistant coach to both the men's and women's programs. Koerner helped lead UOP to a 2013 NCAA Runner-Up finish and has coached 14 NCAA All-Americans. He has served as an assistant coach for the United States Youth National Team since 2011 and led the Youth National Team to a silver medal as head coach at the 2013 Pan American Youth Championships in Buenos Aires, Argentina.

"We are pleased to welcome Zac Koerner to the Jesuit High School Community," athletic director Chris Fahey said. "Zac brings a wealth of coaching experience from the high school, college and national team levels that will benefit our student-athletes in and out of the pool."

Koerner was the Head Coach for Rio Americano High School from 2006-2010, winning a CIF Sacramento Section Championship in 2010. During his tenure, Koerner coached 5 Capital Athletic League Championship teams, while developing 27 All-CIF, 31 All-CAL and 4 All-American players. In addition, Koerner was named the 2007 Division II Coach of the Year for the greater Sacramento area. Koerner is a graduate of the University of California-Irvine, where he played two seasons for the Anteaters and graduated with a B.A. in Humanities-Film Studies.

"I am excited and honored to serve as the water polo coach at Jesuit High School," said Koerner. "The Jesuit Water Polo program has a long tradition of success both in and out of the pool. This is a unique opportunity for me to work with the student-athletes at Jesuit and continue to build on that tradition."

Koerner will be responsible for all water polo operations at Jesuit High School including oversight of the three competition teams. Koerner will continue in his role of Assistant Coach at UOP for the women's team through the spring season.
