## THE SCHOOL

Jesuit High School of Sacramento is a Roman Catholic college preparatory dedicated to forming competent young men into conscientious leaders in compassionate service to others for the greater glory of God. The school's purpose is to serve the young men of the wider Sacramento area, from every ethnic and socio-economic background and a broad spectrum of academic achievement. Enrollment is at capacity and includes a senior class of 227. Traditionally, 98-100% of our graduates go immediately to college, approximately 84% to four-year institutions, approximately 40% to private colleges and universities. Sixty percent of the Jesuit professional and certificated staff hold a Master's Degree or higher.

# **ACCREDITATION**

Jesuit High School of Sacramento is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and the Western Catholic Education Association (WCEA). The current term of WASC accreditation is six years, through 2020. Jesuit is a member of the College Board, the Jesuit Schools Network (60 high schools in the United States) and the National Association for College Admission Counseling.

## COMMUNITY PROFILE

The school's campus straddles the dividing line between the city of Sacramento and the suburban district known as Carmichael. It draws students from more than 70 local elementary and junior high schools. Twenty percent of the student body commutes a distance greater than 20 miles. Nearly 300 students receive tuition assistance and participate in a work-study program. Jesuit has an ethnically diverse student body with a 37% minority population.

#### GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Each year Jesuit students take a maximum of six academic courses. Some students may take an additional credit course each semester for Performing Arts classes. Jesuit's graduation requirements include:

- 8 semesters of English
- 6 semesters of World Language
- 6 semesters of Mathematics (90% take eight semesters or more, 30% take Calculus)
- 6 semesters of Laboratory Science (90% take seven semesters or more)
- 7 semesters of Social Sciences
- 7 semesters of Theology
- 2 semesters of Physical Education and/or Music
- 1 semester of Health Education
- 2 semesters of Visual and Performing Arts
- 8 semesters of Christian Service
- 3 semesters of other College Prep electives

#### Advanced Placement:

Over the past two years (2015 and 2016) 501 students sat for 994 AP tests with 85% receiving grades of "3" or better.

#### National Merit Program:

In the last five years, 8 members of the Classes of 2012-2016 were named National Merit Semi-Finalists and 44 seniors were named Commended Students. The National Hispanic Scholar Recognition Program recognized 29 Jesuit students, and two students were named African-American National Achievement Scholars.
