In the fall of 2009, Jesuit Drama produced *Tower Stories: A 9/11 Project*, a documentary theater-piece about that cataclysmic event which rocked our national consciousness and ushered in a global War on Terror.

Six years later, this original fall production asks what did the United States do during those months and years that followed 9/11 in order to secure the country.

Drawing extensively from a wide variety of first-person accounts, **Terror Stories: A Post 9/11 Project** explores this uniquely challenging, controversial and important time in our recent history, all the while extending Jesuit Drama's commitment to social-justice-minded "Theater of Testimony."

To create this play, our company of twenty-two actors and dozens of technicians have been researching, reporting, formulating, strategizing, drafting, revising, designing, and staging since early September for our fall production run.

**Terror Stories: A Post-9/11 Project** opens Thursday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, and will perform for two weeks in the Black Box Theater located in the Harris Center at Jesuit High School (at the back of the school, O'Donnell Drive off Fair Oaks Blvd.).
