Jesuit High School Seniors-Take Note!

You may be eligible for a significant tuition break in fourteen western states!

How is this possible?

Through the Western Undergraduate Exchange Program (WUE-pronounced “woo-ee”) eligible students in western states (including California) **may be awarded WUE status** to enroll in participating four-year and two-year public college programs at a reduced tuition level: 150% of the institution’s regular resident tuition.

How do I know if I am eligible?

Many institutions require evidence of academic performance, such as a strong **high school GPA or ACT/SAT test scores**, or place other conditions on WUE enrollment. Consult the WUE Bulletin at www.wiche.edu/wue/students and contact the admissions office of the school you are interested in for more details. **Don’t delay.** Many schools grant WUE rates to a **limited number of eligible students**.

How significant is the tuition break?

In all cases, WUE tuition is considerably less than nonresident tuition. Example:

Which schools and what kind of programs are we talking about here?

Some institutions have opened their entire curriculum on a space-available or first-come, first-served basis; **others offer only designated programs or majors**. How do I apply?

Apply for admission and WUE tuition status directly to the institution(s) of your choice. Mark prominently on the institution’s app. form that you seek admission as a WUE student. **Consult the college or university website for any additional requirements.**
