

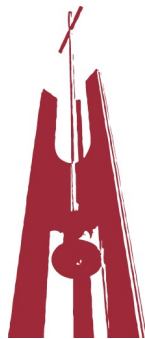


STUDENT WORK PROGRAM

A student who qualifies for our tuition assistance program is required to perform 30 hours of student work. This program is coordinated in our Assistant Dean's Office. Students are contacted through their Jesuit email accounts to schedule their assignments.

Students perform a myriad of jobs on campus, for example: athletic scorekeepers, library assistants, Office of Advancement assistants, Booster Club Crab Feed, and annual PACE Gala & Auction, just to name a few.

Students obtain a time card from the Dean's Office before his assignment. The student is responsible for completing the time card, obtaining appropriate signatures and submitting their time card to the Dean's Office for proper credit. All student work hours must be completed by May 1st.

PROCESS

- ◆ Tuition assistance is available to students with a demonstrated financial need and has no bearing on admission. Through the generosity of our benefactors, we have an established scholarship endowment fund which provides tuition assistance in the form of direct grants and a “work study program.”
- ◆ JHS contracts with Tuition Aid Data Service (TADS) to evaluate applications. Using TADS’ assessment and other materials submitted, the Tuition Assistance Committee determines how much assistance can be offered to a family. Awards are made to students in good standing and are based upon the family’s financial need.

There are two ways to complete a TADS application:



1. ONLINE APPLICATION

Go to www.mytads.com and click on the “Financial Aid” section to begin.

2. PAPER APPLICATION

IMPORTANT NOTES

- ◆ All Families receiving assistance must re-apply each year.
- ◆ For separated or divorced families, the financial responsible party must submit an application if they want to be considered for tuition assistance for their portion of tuition.
- ◆ Only one application per family is necessary. Additionally, if you are applying for a daughter attending St. Francis High School, only one application is needed for both schools. You can associate your application to other schools at the end of the online application.
- ◆ Freshman Decision Letters will be mailed on February 10, 2017. Returning Student Decision Letters will be mailed March 3, 2017.
- ◆ Work Study Program—Our work study program is a component of the total tuition assistance award. Students are required to complete 30 service hours in conjunction with their award.
- ◆ Payment Plan Options:
 - One annual payment due August 1
 - Two payments due August 1 & January 2
 - Ten monthly installments
- ◆ Credit cards are not accepted for tuition.
- ◆ Tuition assistance is restricted to tuition charges only and will be applied automatically to your selected payment plan.
