CAMP MARAUDER PHILOSOPHY

The Camp Marauder Summer Program values education and recreation as important foundations for each individual's development. We believe in providing a safe, nurturing, and enjoyable atmosphere where school-age participants can learn, grow, and build friendships through positive experiences. Our program is designed to meet the individual needs of the campers by supporting their emotional, physical, intellectual, and social growth through developmentally appropriate educational and recreation based curriculum. Our goal is for each participant in Camp Marauder to begin to understand what it means to be a part of the Jesuit brotherhood and community, and to create a desire within each one of them to be young men for others.

DAYS AND HOURS OF OPERATION

- Session 1 will take place from June 16 through June 27.
- Camp Marauder is closed on June 19th.
- Session 2 will take place from July 7 through July 18.
- The program is open 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday during this four-week period.

STAFF

- Staff will be outfitted in color coded shirts, allowing clear distinction of duties. Lifeguards will be wearing gold shirts and are CPR, First Aid, and Lifeguard certified.
- Staff will consist of trained Morning Leads, Counselors, Lifeguards, and Directors.
- The Camp Marauder Office (Harris Center Music Recital Hall) will be staffed by a Camp Director at all times.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

- Students must check-in at their appropriate location upon arrival.
- Students may check themselves in. A parent is not necessary.
- Students are welcome to check-in beginning at 8:00 a.m. with the morning counselor. Please do not arrive before 8:00 a.m., unless you requested early drop-off when you registered your camper.
- Please check-in by 8:45 a.m.
- Late arriving students (after 9:00 a.m.) please report to the Camp Marauder Office in the Harris Center – Music Recital Hall and check-in with attending staff member.

CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE

- Check-out will be located in the Harris Center for both Camp Marauder and Camp Marauder Jr.
- Student check-out begins at 2:30 p.m.
- Students must be checked out **no later than 2:45 p.m.** (**or 5:00 p.m.** if you requested the Extended Rec Games and Activities Program when you registered your camper.)
- Students cannot check themselves out. A parent or designated adult must be present.
- Early arriving parents will be asked to wait in the Harris Center Lobby and/or outside the Harris Center.
- Once check-out opens, parents enter the Harris Center through the lobby doors and pick-up students to be signed out.

- Parents will sign students out at the designated sign-out table.
- Parents should exit through the doors next to the sign-out table.

PLANNED EARLY PICK-UP

• Please provide a note at morning check-in if you know there will be a planned early pick-up. Counselors and Directors will be notified of the early pick-up. Location for early pick-up of students is located in the Camp Marauder Office in the Harris Center – Music Recital Hall.

UNPLANNED EARLY PICK-UP

• In the event of an unplanned early pick-up, please contact the Camp Marauder Office by email at campmarauder@jesuithighschool.org, or phone at 279-900-5179 and include the camper's name and time of pick-up. Counselors and Directors will be notified of the early pick-up and the camper will be taken to the Camp Marauder Office. Location for early pick-up of students is located in the Camp Marauder Office in the Harris Center – Music Recital Hall.

PLANNED ABSENCE PROCEDURE

Please provide a note at morning check in if you know there will be a planned future absence.
Counselors and Directors will be notified of planned absence. To otherwise report an absence or
early dismissal, (or in case of a problem/emergency) please contact the Camp Marauder Office at
279-900-5179. Location for early pick-up of students is located in the Camp Marauder Office
in the Harris Center – Music Recital Hall.

EARLY RELEASE OF SICK STUDENT

- Please do not bring your child to Camp Marauder / Camp Marauder Jr. if he is ill.
- If your child becomes ill while at Jesuit, parents will be notified and asked to come and pick up the child.
- If parents cannot come and get the student, the emergency designee will be notified.
- Location for early pick-up of students is located in the Camp Marauder Office in the Harris Center Music Recital Hall.

MEDICINE

- Children may not bring medicine to the Jesuit campus.
- If it is absolutely necessary that a physician's prescribed medication be taken by a child, it may be brought in by the parent and presented to a staff member at check-in.
- Camp Marauder must be given their own supply of medication (in original prescription container).
 Prescribed medication may be administered by the Program Directors only with a written statement from the physician detailing the method, amount, and time schedules by which the medication is to be taken.
- A written statement from the parent must be included, indicating the parent's authorization and desire that the medication be given as directed by the physician
- Any vitally important medications will be carried by the camper's counselor to keep it near the prescribed if needed.
- Over-the-counter medication requires authorization from a parent via written note or over the phone.

STUDENTS MUST BRING THE FOLLOWING TO CAMP:

A swim suit, towel & sunscreen, clearly marked with the student's name. We will swim
 everyday (weather permitting). No one is excused unless they have a <u>note</u> from their parent
 /doctor. Changing facilities are provided at the pool. We encourage all students to wear their
 swimsuits to camp to save time on changing.

- A lunch (We have a food service on campus that is open during the Camp Marauder program and the menu will be available online at the school website) and a water bottle/jug clearly marked with the camper's name. Hydration is essential before, during and after camp especially with warm summer weather conditions.
- A bag or backpack (labeled with the student's name) to hold these items. We "strongly" suggest
 including a plastic bag to hold wet items such as swimsuit and towel. Damage to books is the
 student's responsibility.
- Money for other items such as water, milk, etc. Please do not bring more than \$10 on a daily basis, as the items sold at the food service are under \$10
- School supplies (notebooks, pens, pencils, book) will be provided. Students will bring all of their bags into the classroom with them. Please do not bring valuables (such as iPods, iPads, etc) to camp as we cannot guarantee these items against theft. Please no personal toys, trading cards, etc. Students are not allowed to bring personal items to sell during camp (ie. Pokeman cards, baseball cards or the like.)
- Homework will not be assigned and students will be given a written evaluation. We expect the students to remain focused in class, work on their academic skills and enjoy the structured recreation, swim and athletic periods.
- **Dress Code**: Shorts or pants, shirts, tank tops, athletic shoes (necessary for athletic participation.) Some students just wear swim trunks and a t-shirt, so they dry quickly and that is acceptable as well.

LATE DROP-OFF OF ITEMS

- All items brought to camp late, and intended to be for use of the camper, should be delivered to the Camp Marauder Office (Harris Center – Music Recital Hall).
- Items to be dropped off include: medication, money, food, clothing, swimming gear, books, etc.
- Directors and Counselors will be notified of the item's arrival, and it will be delivered to the camper at the earliest possible opportunity.
