FROM CAMPUS TO COMMUNITY: THE RIPPLE EFFECT OF YOUR GENEROSITY

A MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Jesuit community,

Your support forms students who, in turn, transform lives through acts of service like our legendary food drive. This tradition, held every year during Advent, began more than half a century ago—and its impact still echoes our Marauders today.

A few weeks ago, shortly after Christmas, I met with a member of Jesuit High School Sacramento's first graduating class for coffee. This Class of 1967 alum's eyes grew wide as we talked about the role service has played in his life, a lifelong commitment that began his freshman year. His words say it best:

"In 1963, our freshman year, we started Jesuit's Christmas Food Drive. We had 93 students in our class, which was the whole student body at the time. We collected enough food to feed and provide groceries for three families, and I was one of the students who helped deliver the food. Although it's been over six decades, I have never forgotten that experience of helping families in need. This is why I continue volunteering today."

He went on to describe, in vivid detail, something from each family he visited that day as if it happened yesterday—one family's rows and rows of tamales they were making to sell in the community, another's distinctive wallpaper and home decor, and the third's cherished pet cat. But most of all, he remembered how each family received him and his classmates into their homes as they cared for their neighbors. That's the power of formative experiences—and that's what your generosity makes possible through a Jesuit education.

That first 1963 Christmas food drive continued and evolved, and for the last 56 years has benefited the broader Sacramento community through the Stanford Settlement Neighborhood Center. Today, our young men are still living their Ignatian values through their actions, working alongside faculty, staff, and families who came together for the 2025 Operation Cratchit Food Drive. This year, the drive raised over \$50,000 in combined dollars and donations.

RECAP OF OPERATION CRATCHIT

As impressive as these numbers are, the most inspiring part is this: no one got any extra credit. Every pound donated, every dollar raised was given freely, without strings attached. In a time when so much feels transactional, our students acted out of pure generosity.

Could we have collected more if we'd attached extra-credit points? Maybe. But what did we gain by giving our students the chance to do something so generous without any thought of reward? We gained what matters most: the formation of hearts and minds—the shaping of young Men for Others.

Now, as you turn the page and read through these stories and statistics of impact and the long lists of generous benefactors to Jesuit Sacramento, know this: **your support makes this possible.** Your support is fundamental to our efforts. **Your gifts form students who, in turn, form the world.** Students who make their lives a generous offering to God and neighbor, an unflinching response of love to a God who loves us all without limit or condition.

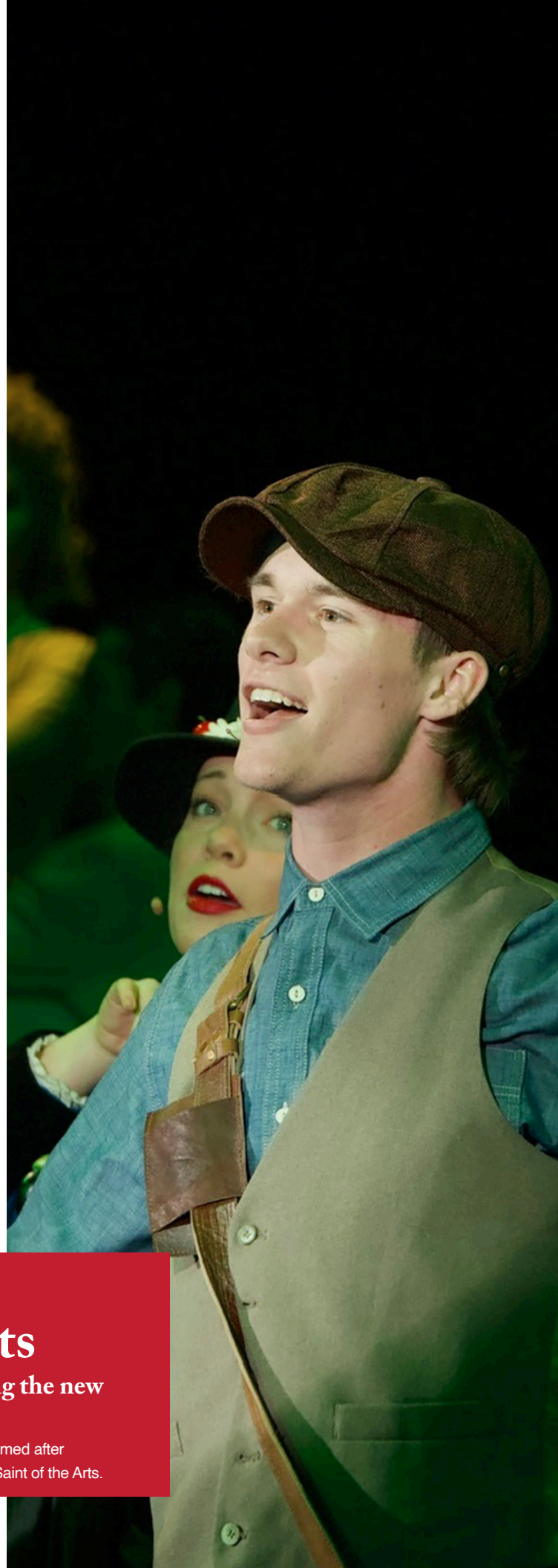

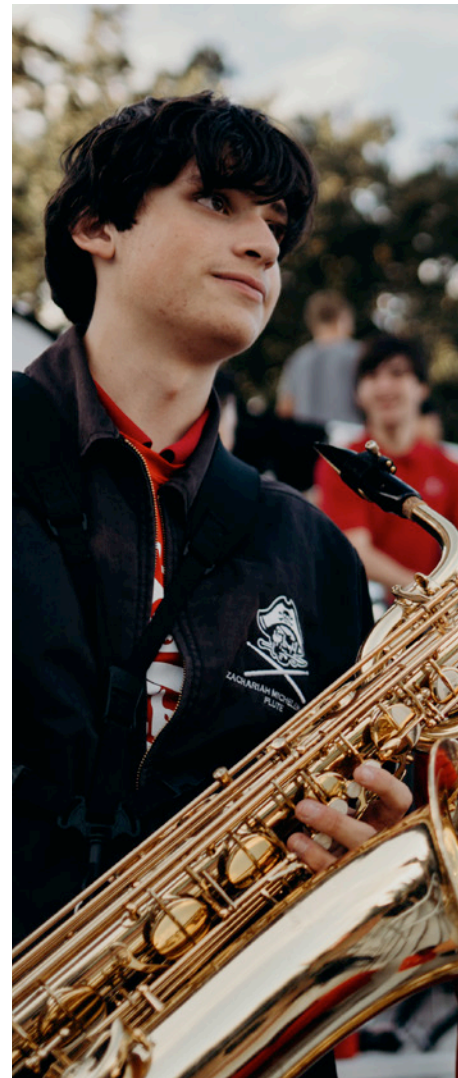

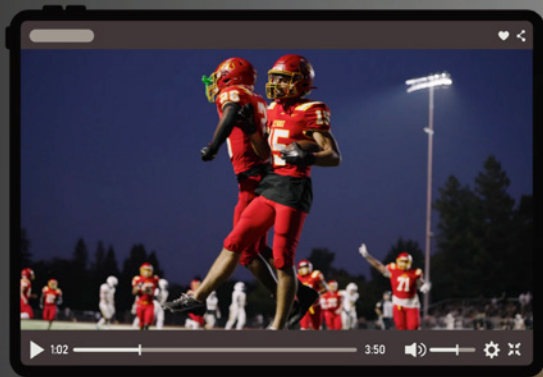

For four days, we worked under the sun handing off buckets of sand and gravel to each other, moving cement bags, and mixing cement. It was hard work, but doing it alongside the community made it worthwhile. Everyone pitched in. The people we met made this experience memorable. The first night we arrived, kids and families came to the school where we were staying to welcome us. Despite the language barrier, we were able to communicate with laughter and smiles. The children were unforgettable. They came to the worksite every day, curious and eager to watch as we worked, and they loved spending time with us after we finished for the day. Being able to play games with them after work was the highlight of each day.

This immersion taught us a lot about perspective. Being in a small Panamanian community, we saw firsthand how people live with fewer resources than we are used to in America. It made us realize how much we take for granted in our life. This immersion showed us that happiness doesn't come from having a lot of things but from community, family, and friendships. It is a lesson we won't forget.

In the end, Panama was more than just a trip or a vacation. It was a chance to serve, learn, and connect with others. We left with memories we will never forget, a new appreciation for things we take for granted, and an insight into the power of community.

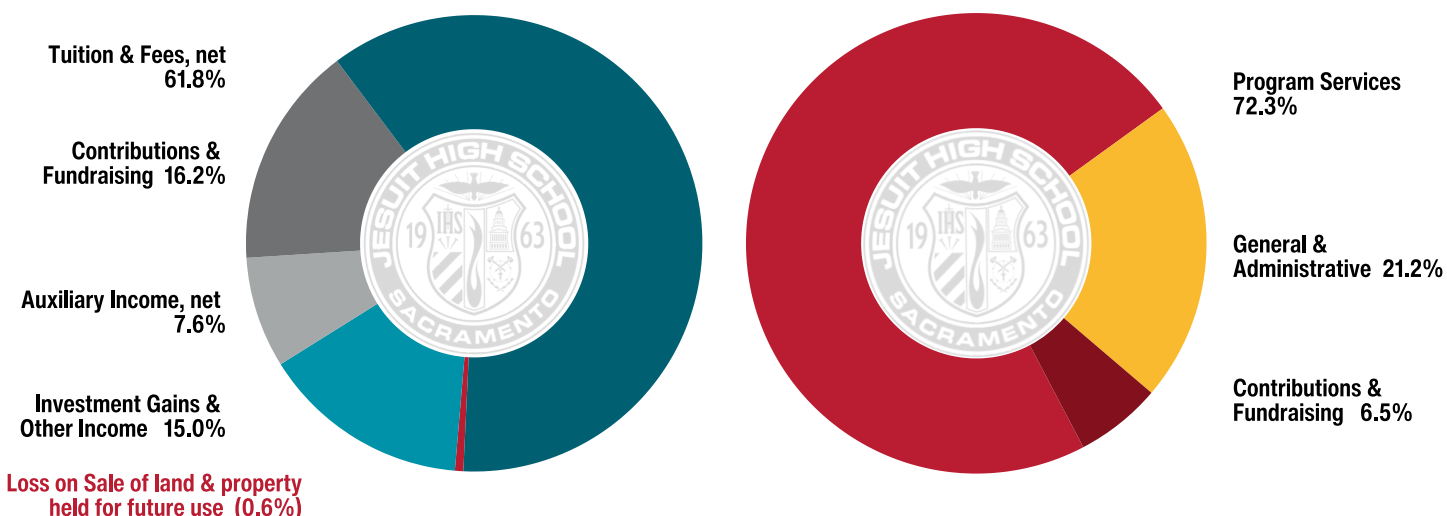
**Notes on Unaudited Statement of Activities

*Notes on Audited Statement of Activities

Net assets without donor restrictions. Net assets available for use in general operations and not subject to donor-imposed restrictions. The School's governing board may designate net asset without restrictions for specific purposes. **School Operations, and Property & Equipment are included in this category.**

Net assets with donor restrictions. Net assets subject to stipulations imposed by donors and grantors. Some donor restrictions are temporary in nature, such as those that will be met by the passage of time or other events specified by the donor. Other donor-imposed restrictions are perpetual in nature, whereby the donor has stipulated the funds be maintained in perpetuity. Net assets with donor restrictions also include the portion of donor-restricted endowment funds that are not required to be maintained in perpetuity, until such funds are appropriated for expenditure by the School. Donor-imposed restrictions are released when a restriction expires, that is, when the stipulated time has elapsed, when the stipulated purpose for which the resource was restricted has been fulfilled, or both.



NAMED SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship gifts are invested in Jesuit's Scholarship Endowment. Income from the endowment is used each year to provide financial aid awards to academically qualified Jesuit students with demonstrated financial need. In addition, sponsorships and gifts given during our annual Scholarship Event Coffee for a Cause help change the lives of students at Jesuit, not only during their four years on campus, but for the rest of their lives.
