1. You must have a valid icon the day of your test to be allowed in the testing room. Please plan to attend your weekly COVID screen as if it was a normal school day / week. You must test once per week to be allowed on campus. Please plan your COVID screen so that you are not late for your AP test. **COVID screening begins at 7:00am. If you have a morning test on Monday, you need to be on campus and ready to be screened at 7:00am or have tested the previous Thursday.** Your COVID test is valid for one week. Please plan accordingly given your AP Exam schedule. **Do not arrive on campus at 7:15am and expect to be on time to your morning AP test if you have to be screened for COVID!**
2. Students are prohibited from bringing electronic equipment (cell phone, smart phone, smartwatch, laptop, tablet computer, etc.) portable listening devices (MP3, etc.), cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the Internet, or any other electronic or communication device with them to the testing room. **Since you will need your device to validate your COVID icon, please plan on leaving your phone/device with Mrs. Wagner and picking it up at the conclusion of your test.**
3. Students should only bring exam materials (number 2 pencils, eraser, ball point pens with black or dark blue ink, acceptable calculator with extra batteries if permitted) and snack food to the testing room. Snack food should be left in the Harris Center lobby and will be accessible during the break.
4. **Students should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start of their exam (7:30 a.m. for morning exams and 12:00 p.m. for afternoon exams).** No late arriving students will be admitted once students have completed the identification information on their answer sheet. **Testing will not be delayed under any circumstances for late arriving students.**
