#### PHASE 2

#### **REAL-TIME ENGAGEMENT**

(Synchronous Procedure)

## Includes the following major updates/changes:

- Addition of real-time (synchronous) class sessions
- Departure from daily posting of assignments to using a weeklong plan

## **REAL-TIME SESSIONS** may only be scheduled within these timeframes:

- If an All Day were to meet: 9:00am – 9:25am: Period 1
  9:30am – 9:55am: Period 2
  10:00am – 10:25am: Period 3
  10:30am – 10:55am: Period 4
  11:00am – 11:25am: Period 5
  11:30am – 11:55am: Period 6
  12:00pm – 12:25pm: Period 7
- If an Odd Day were to meet:
- 9:00am 9:45am: Period 1
- 10:00am 10:45am: Period 3
- 11:00am 11:45am: Period 5
- 1:00pm 1:45pm: Period 7
- If an Even Day were to meet:
- 9:00am 9:45am: Period 2
- 10:00am 10:45am: Period 4
- 11:00am 11:45am: Period 6
- 1:00pm 1:45pm: Teacher Collaboration

#### DEFINITION

- Students learn at the same time in a virtual class with their teacher and peers
- Class engages all at a specific date & time determined by individual teachers
- Examples: live chat, video conferencing

#### PROCEDURE

Class sessions are meant to simulate an in-person classroom session. Though optional for students, these are highly encouraged.

- Virtual session must be done using Zoom or Google Meet. Students unable to attend live may view the recording later.
- Sessions should be 45 minutes maximum. Sessions scheduled on All Days should be 25 minutes maximum.
- The number of real-time sessions will be at the teacher's discretion. Teachers will use the arranged schedule to avoid conflicts.
- Sessions should contribute to a feeling of connectedness to the community & add to the student learning experience
- Session times must be posted to Google Classroom in the weekly plan

#### **OFFICE HOURS**

## Office hours may be scheduled outside of the real-time session windows:

- May be live meetings using Zoom or Google Meet
- Can also use immediate email responses, or chatroom meetings. Teachers should clearly post times that they will be "live" responding to student emails or comments
- These sessions are meant for assignment clarification, individual student questions, review, & fellowship.

#### **FLEXIBLE ENGAGEMENT**

(Asynchronous Procedure)

#### DEFINITION

- Students learn on their own schedule within the parameters set by individual teachers
- Students work at their own pace
- Examples: videos, screencasts, individual assignments, projects

#### PROCEDURE

# Assignments will now follow a new schedule. Student work will be given due times of 9am the <u>next</u> "scheduled" class meeting day

- Teachers will construct & communicate a weekly plan for their students. The plan will be posted the 1st day of each week & will include all assignments with specific due dates & times for each assignment.
- Assignment posts must include:
  - Instructions for work to be completed
  - Specific due date, always with a 9am submission time the <u>next</u> class meeting day
