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| TRAVEL non-athletic | <p>All overnight and air travel scheduled for the purpose of instruction or business continuity, occurring as planned, this includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Overnight field trips (including science camps) • Professional development related travel • Refer to CDC precautionary travel guidelines as some countries have restricted travel and/or require self-quarantine measures |
| TRAVEL athletics | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All California Interscholastic Federation (CIF) sponsored athletic in competitions will be held as scheduled, with the appropriate settings in place for enhanced preventative care measures • Non-CIF sponsored athletic events will be held on a case-by-case basis per opposing team/facility availability |
| VPA drama/choir/band/ orchestra | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All band, choir, theater and dance tryouts or performances are occurring as planned • Band/choir and dance competitions will continue based on event & using enhanced preventative care measures as well as any modifications needed |
| EVENTS school | <p>All school events are occurring as planned with enhanced preventative care measures. Events include, but are not limited to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Instructional and/or extracurricular related events (masses, assemblies, dances) • Professional development trainings • Booster/Guild organized events and meetings • Student organized events, including those organized by ASB and school clubs |
| EVENTS other events held on-campus | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All non-school events are occurring as planned with enhanced preventative care measures. • If needed, those with scheduled events, gatherings or performances should contact their regular JHS representative to evaluate options for rescheduling |
| SERVICE requirements | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On a case-by-case basis per site, students are responsible for checking in with off-site organizations and facilities • Students will not be penalized for not meeting their required hours at this time |
| DAILY LIFE lunch, common areas | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Common Areas (library, multipurpose room) and cafeteria/eating areas will continue to use enhanced preventative care measures |
| MEETINGS faculty, committee | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Professional development, committee and department meetings will continue as planned |
| ILLNESS student | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students are encouraged to stay home or go home if feeling ill • Students with symptoms of illness will be assessed by a staff member and may be sent home • Students sent home must be picked up by a parent or person on their emergency contact list • A student with a fever and respiratory illness symptoms will be isolated with a surgical mask, if tolerated, until they are able to leave • Students will continue to receive reminders about best practices for universal precautions |
| ILLNESS employee | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employees are encouraged to stay home or go home if feeling ill • Employees with symptoms of illness will be assessed by a staff member and may be sent home • An employee with a fever and respiratory illness symptoms will be isolated with a surgical mask, if tolerated, until they are able to leave |
