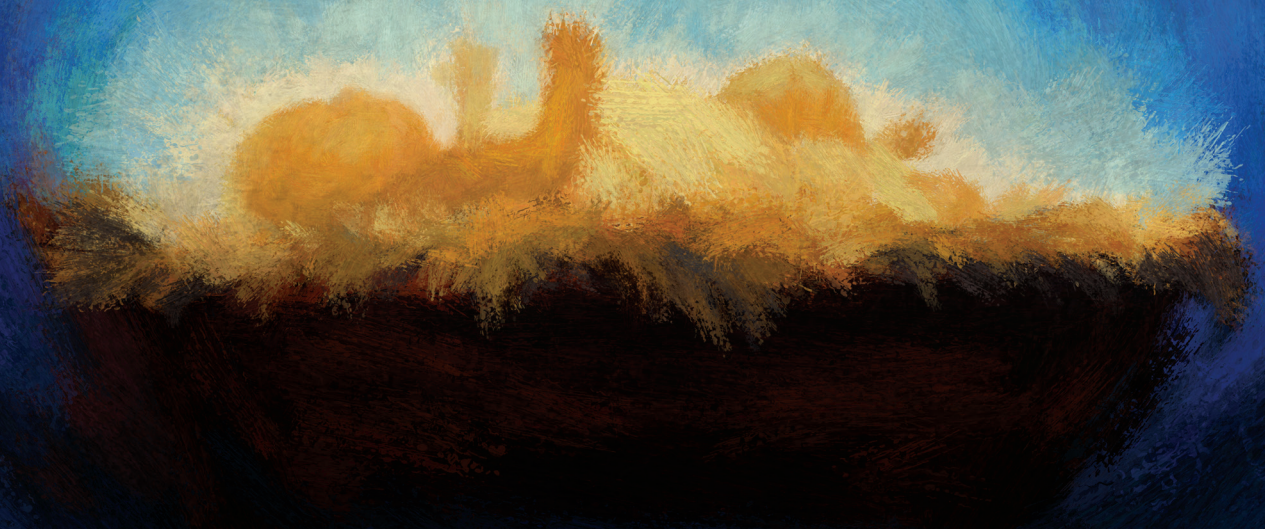

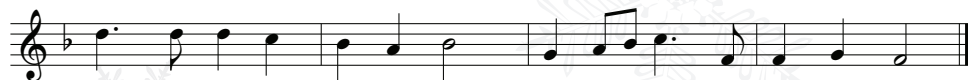

In 1918, the Dean of King's College, Cambridge University, 34-year-old Eric Milner-White, desired to create an Advent prayer service that would invite the participation of readers and singers of various ages from the university as well as from the town of Cambridge. He wove together scripture and song into a Service of Nine Lessons and Carols, a liturgical celebration of the Advent season intended to remind the faithful of the promises of old now fulfilled in the birth of our Savior. We are proud to continue this tradition in the Jeffrey '80 and Elizabeth Phelan Chapel of the North American Martyrs in our own way, using traditional and contemporary hymns and texts.
