STEP 1 GET STARTED


If you choose Student, follow the onscreen instructions to confirm your information so it can be used to accurately tag photos.





STEP 3 VERIFY YOUR EMAIL


Check your inbox for the email address you provided for your one-time code. Enter the 6-digit code and tap Verify to continue.






STEP 4 CHOOSE SHARING OPTION






Tag Multiple Photos With The Same People And Topics All At Once With Fast Tag

- If you selected Student when providing your contact information, your name will already appear in the "Tagged section of the photos area."
- To remove a name or topic tag, tap the X next to it in the "Tagged section" of the photos area "Added topics areas."



TIPS FOR

- To remove a name or topic tag, tap the X next to it in the Tagged in photo or Added topics areas.
- The character limit for a caption is 400 characters.
- On the review screen, you can tap

 Fast
 Tag to launch it at any time.






STEP 5 REVIEW & SUBMIT
