- YOU NEED 50 HOURS OF SUPERVISED DRIVING EXPERIENCE WITH AN ADULT TO OBTAIN A CALIFORNIA DRIVER LICENSE.
- IT TAKES ONLY SIX
 HOURS OF SUPERVISED
 BEHIND THE WHEEL
 EXPERIENCE WITH A
 CERTIFIED DRIVING
 INSTRUCTOR TO GET A
 CALIFORNIA DRIVER
 LICENSE. YET, A
 MANICURIST MUST
 COMPLETE 400 HOURS
 UNDER SUPERVISION TO
 BE LICENSED IN THE
 STATE OF CALIFORNIA!
 TEEN DRIVERS ARE AT
 HIGHEST RISK.
- THE CRASH RATE (PER MILE DRIVEN) FOR 16 YEAR OLDS IS FOUR TIMES THAT OF ADULT DRIVERS.
- HAVING PASSENGERS IS A SERIOUS DISTRACTION FOR TEEN DRIVERS. CARRYING THREE OR MORE PASSENGERS INCREASES THE RISK OF A CRASH FOR 16 AND 17 YEAR OLDS THREE-FOLD COMPARED TO DRIVING ALONE.
