THE SCHOOL

Jesuit High School of Sacramento is a Roman Catholic college preparatory dedicated to forming competent young men into conscientious leaders in compassionate service to others for the greater glory of God. The school's purpose is to serve the young men of the wider Sacramento area, from every ethnic and socio-economic background and a broad spectrum of academic achievement. Enrollment is at capacity and includes a senior class of 260. Traditionally, 98-100% of our graduates go immediately to college, approximately 85% to four-year institutions, approximately 33% to private colleges and universities. Sixty-five percent of the Jesuit professional and certificated staff hold a Master's Degree or higher.

ACCREDITATION

Jesuit High School of Sacramento is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and the Western Catholic Education Association (WCEA). The current term of WASC accreditation is six years, through 2020. Jesuit is a member of the College Board, the Jesuit Schools Network (62 high schools in the US), the National Association for College Admission Counseling and the American School Counselor Association.

COMMUNITY PROFILE

The school's campus straddles the dividing line between the city of Sacramento and the suburban district known as Carmichael. It draws students from more than 80 local elementary and junior high schools. Twenty-one percent of the student body commutes a distance greater than 20 miles. Approximately 260 students receive tuition assistance. Jesuit has an ethnically diverse student body with approximately 36% minority population.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Each year Jesuit students take a maximum of six academic courses. Some students may take an additional credit course each semester for Visual and Performing Arts classes. Jesuit's graduation requirements include:

- 8 semesters of English
- 6 semesters of World Language
- 6 semesters of Mathematics (98% take eight semesters or more, 35% take Calculus)
- 6 semesters of Laboratory Science (90% take seven semesters or more)
- 7 semesters of Social Sciences
- 7 semesters of Theology
- 2 semesters of Physical Education
- 1 semester of Health Education
- 2 semesters of Visual and Performing Arts
- 8 semesters of Christian Service
- 3 semesters of other College Prep electives

Upon request, the school will report a cumulative grade point average based on all academic work accomplished at Jesuit High School from grade nine onward. Courses taken outside Jesuit High School are reported on the transcript but not calculated in the GPA. This GPA will be given on either a traditional 4 point scale or a weighted honors scale (additional grade point for each AP, honors, or XL class). We do not compute student rank. A student's decile rank in class can be determined by his regular or honors GPA (for reference, see *Class of 2019* distribution below).

Over the past two years (2018 and 2019) 654 students sat for 1448 AP tests with 79% receiving grades of "3" or better.

National Merit Program:

In the last five years, 1 member was named a **National Merit Finalist**, 4 members were named **National Merit Semi-Finalists** and 29 seniors were named **Commended Students**. The **National Hispanic Scholar Recognition Program** recognized 41 Jesuit students, and two students were named African-American **National Achievement Scholars**.
