

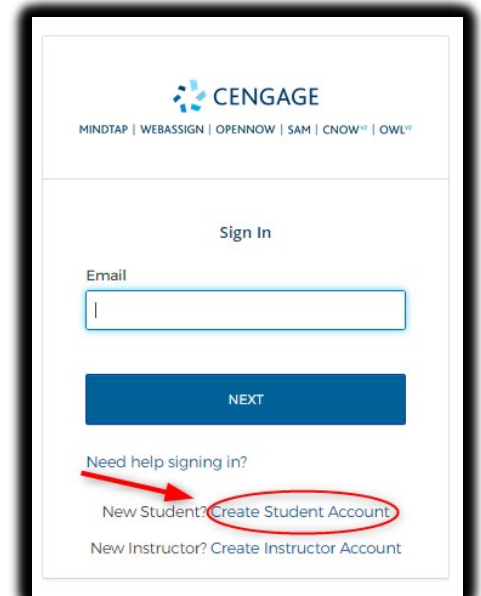
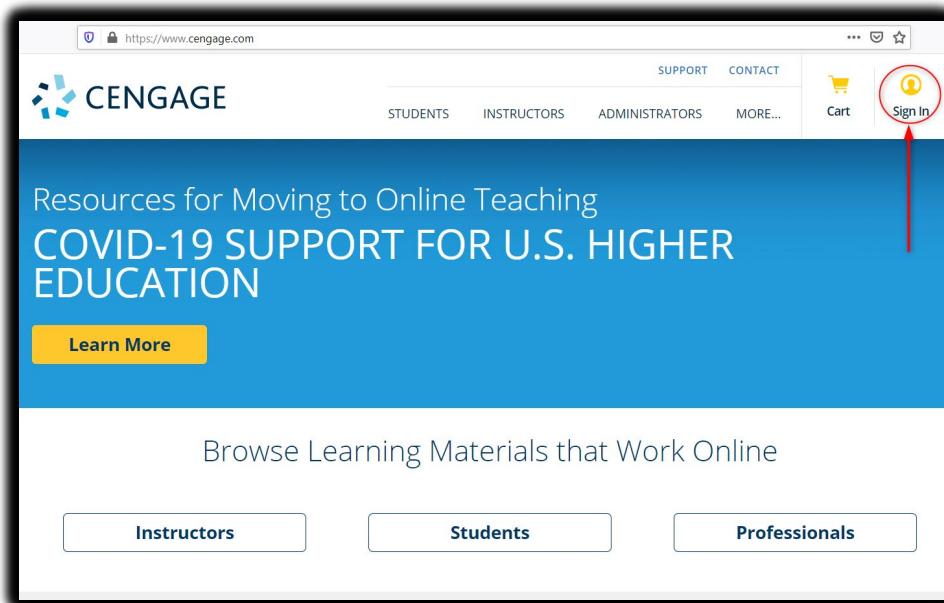
Summer/Fall 2021 Jesuit HS purchasing instructions for Big Ideas Math textbooks and Online Access w/ebook

***Please follow the step-by-step instructions on this walkthrough to ensure that your order is placed properly and frustration-free!**

1. You will first need to create a *Student Account* at Cengage.com *Please note, this is only for purchasing purposes; this account, once created, will NOT be used for digital fulfillment (more on that further down).

- To create an account, navigate to Cengage.com and click the 'Sign In' button on the top right and create a new *student account* and then walk through the account creation process.

*Make sure to select Jesuit HS in Sacramento, CA on the school pull down menu, not any other Jesuit High School choices within other cities.



2. Once the online account at Cengage.com is created, in the same browser, copy and paste the URL below to this Microsite which will take you to Jesuit High School's ordering page for Big Ideas Math.

3. Once you have added your products to the cart and the *Complete Purchase* button is checked, you will receive a confirmation page that you can print a receipt or a pdf receipt from. You will also receive an email with your order confirmation to the email address you created the student account with.

IMPORTANT/PLEASE NOTE:

- Print books will ship directly to the address you indicate on your order.
- The digital licensing for this product WILL NOT be provided through the order confirmation screens or receipts. Please do not try to create a MindTap account through the Cengage.com account you created, or Cengage Brain. The student licensing and account creation information is on a different website than Cengage.com and will be communicated to your student from Jesuit HS's math department for the course.
- With this purchase, the digital licensing will be deposited into Jesuit's account and will be held on your student's behalf until the teacher communicates instructions to the student prior to the start of your school session.
